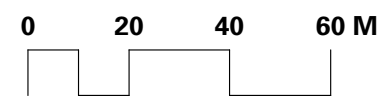

- A** **Main Oval** (existing)
 A1 Main oval is the primary AFL ground.
 A2 Main oval is the secondary cricket ground (synthetic wicket).
 A3 New scoreboard (LED full-colour screen).
 A4 New football netball club courts (2).
 A5 Extended fence / net structure for protection from errant footballs.
- B** **New Second Oval** (155m x 130m)
 B1 Second oval is the primary cricket ground (synthetic wicket).
 B2 Second oval is the secondary AFL ground.
 B3 Install sub-surface drainage and irrigation.
 B4 Informal perimeter car parking on match days only.
 B5 New cricket practice nets (4).
 B6 New combined scoreboard and cricket store and ball trapment fence.
- C** **New Main Community Pavilion**
 C1 Changerooms to service the main oval (Stage 1).
 C2 Joint-use club and community function room (Stage 2).
 C3 Changerooms to service the second oval and netball (Stage 3).
 C4 Spectator seating.
 C5 Paved forecourt.
 C6 Local level playground to service visitors to sporting activities.
- D** **Existing Pavilion**
 D1 Retain existing changerooms to service the second oval (short-medium term).
 D2 Existing social rooms retained as the football, netball and cricket clubrooms.
 D3 New public toilets to service the family recreation area and youth activity space.
- E** **Existing Tennis Facility**
 E1 Existing plexipave courts (6).
 E2 Future new tennis courts (2).
 E3 Existing tennis clubrooms.

- F** **New Regional Netball Complex**
 F1 Possible future regional netball courts (8).
 F2 Show court with permanent tiered seating.
 F3 Netball amenities block and administration centre.
 F4 Netball shelters.
- G** **Passive Recreational Zones and Picnic Area**
 G1 Existing Scout / Venturer buildings and car park.
 G2 Potential new youth recreation area to comprise of District level skate park and Basketball half court.
 G3 Paved BBQ and picnic area to comprise of shelter, BBQ, tables and bench seats.
 G4 Regional playground.
 G5 Informal seating throughout open space area.
 G6 Potential dog off-leash area and overflow car parking on major event days.

- H** **Traffic Management**
 H1 Reserve western entry.
 H2 Car park to service picnic and youth areas (12 spaces).
 H3 Car park to service user groups on second oval (40 spaces).
 H4 Roundabout to facilitate passenger drop-off and pick-up.
 H5 Car park to service tennis club use (12 spaces).
 H6 Main reserve car park (183 spaces).
 H7 Reserve eastern entry.
 H8 Entry and unsealed link road used on event days only.
 H9 Unsealed spectator car park used on event days only (115 spaces).
- I** **Ornamental Entry (Heritage Gates)**
 I1 Relocate heritage gates to allow for new intersection.
 I2 Paved concourse with feature landscaping.
