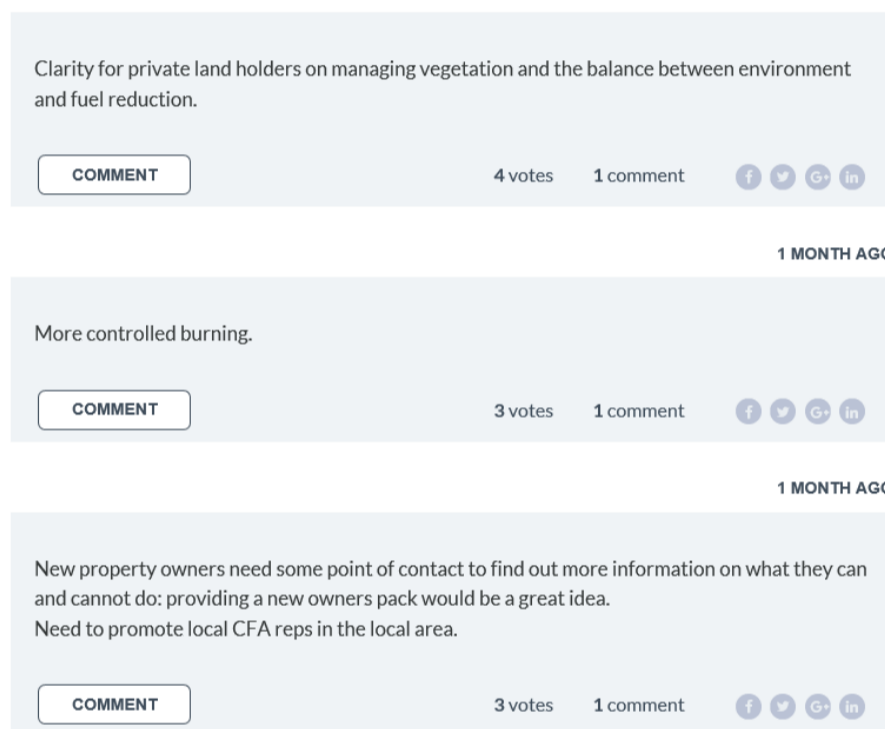
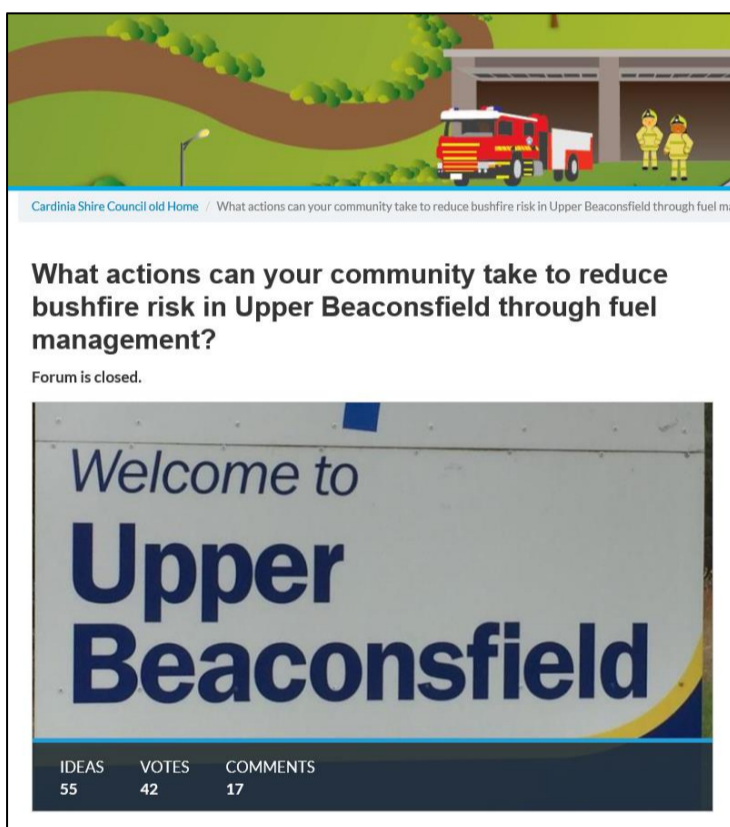


Upper Beaconsfield Fuel Management Project Stakeholder Update
