Important information

What to bring to your immunisation session:

- Your Child Health Record Book – this contains your child's reference number, which will enable quick access to all your child's details
- Medicare Card (if you do not have Medicare you may still attend a Council immunisation session)
- Your child's comfort device or special toy (if needed)

Following all vaccinations, we recommended you wait for 15 minutes before leaving, just to check for possible reactions.

If your child has been ill, please seek advice from your family doctor about whether it is appropriate for them to attend an immunisation session.

Your child's immunisation records will be forwarded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR). This data base is used to process school entry immunisation records and family allowance relating to immunisation.
