It uses pictures to explain some ideas.



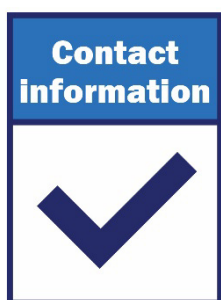
You can ask for help to read this checklist.

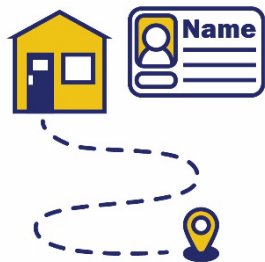

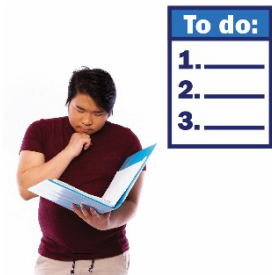
Emergency meeting places
