#### 1.0 STANDARD B1 – NEIGHBOURHOOD CHARACTER & INFRASTRUCTURE.

The site is located in an area designated as a general Residential Zone – Schedule 1 as defined by the Cardinia Shire Planning Scheme.

The units have been designed to respond to the surrounding area and the features of the site.

It is felt that 13 no units (Single & Double) was appropriate to this site.

The proposed units will have a conc. slab floor with the floor level set as low as possible (whilst allowing to accommodate the garage), with selected face brickwork / lining boards and pitched tiled roofs.

The use of these colour schemes and construction methods is in keeping with that in the surrounding area whilst also using modern day colour schemes.

The development will also consist of a good level of new landscaping throughout the site.

The proposal will build on the existing character of the site and neighbourhood.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B1 of Rescode.

#### 2.0 STANDARD B2 - RESIDENTIAL POLICY.

This application & proposal complies with the State Planning Policy Framework, the Local Planning Policy Framework, the Municipal Strategic Statement and Local Planning Policies where ever applicable, if in fact it is applicable.

It is considered that the development Councils Planning Policy and therefore Standard B2 of Rescode.

#### 3.0 STANDARD B3- DWELLING DIVERSITY.

As the proposed development consists of 13 No dwellings, the proposed development is individually designed with a mix of 2 bedroom &3 bedroom single storey and double storey units, to work with the constraints of the site, with the units setback, separated and landscaped.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B3 of Rescode.



#### 4.0 <u>STANDARD B4- INFRASTRUCTURE.</u>

The proposed paved areas within the site has been minimised and as much paving as possible will be graded towards the new landscaped areas provided, so as to maximise the on-site capacity of stormwater.

All necessary services such as electricity, gas and telephone are available for use to this site, and there is open space availability provided for these services.

There should be little or no additional strain on the existing infrastructure such as drainage, roads, social and community services.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B4 of Rescode.

#### 5.0 STANDARD B5 – INTERGRATION WITH THE STREET.

The development involves 2 new crossovers to access the Unit 1 and Units 2-13. The existing access point is proposed to be removed.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B5 of Rescode.

#### 6.0 STANDARD B6 - STREET SETBACK OBJECTIVE.

The proposed unit 1 setback from Ahern Road 8.850m and Unit 13 setback from Ahern Road 9.376.

The proposed setbacks are similar to neighbouring properties.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B6 of Rescode

#### 7.0 STANDARD B7- BUILDING HEIGHT.

The maximum building height for this development does not exceed 9 metres in height. Please refer to elevations for proposed building heights.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B7 of Rescode

#### 8.0 <u>STANDARD B8- SITE COVERAGE.</u>

The site area covered by buildings is 37.86% site coverage, below the maximum of 60%.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B8 of Rescode.

#### 9.0 STANDARD BO9- PERMEABILITY.

The total pervious area of the site will be 622.00m<sup>2</sup> or 43.00%, some 37.00% less than the maximum 80% allowable as stated in Rescode.

Also, as stated previously, as much paving as possible will be graded towards the new landscaped areas so as to maximise the on-site capacity of stormwater and also minimise the effect on local drainage networks.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B9 of Rescode



#### 10.0 STANDARD B10- ENERGY EFFICIENCY.

The units proposed for this development has been oriented to make appropiate use of solar energy. The units have been sited and designed to ensure that the energy efficiency proposed units on our site & adjoining lots is not reasonably reduced. Living areas and private open space has been orientated to the north side of this development, and the Private Open Spaces, have been designed, to allow for existing trees to remain, and not adversely affect the tree on the neighboring property.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B10 of Rescode

#### 11.0 STANDARD B11- OPEN SPACE.

Due to the small nature of the development, no communal open space has been provided within the development.

There is therefore no need to integrate the layout of the development with either communal or public open space however the development has been designed with the location of neighbouring open space in mind.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B11 of Rescode.

#### 12.0 STANDARD B12- SAFETY.

The Proposed units have been provided with a separate entrance to ensure individual identity, clear visibility to visitors etc. and personal security.

The units have been designed and positioned to allow individual identity creating a sense of personal address.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B12 of Rescode.

#### 13.0 STANDARD B13- LANDSCAPING.

The development has been provided with reasonably dense landscaping proposed throughout the site, located around each unit and also along the driveway to reduce the visual impact of the driveways from the street.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B13 of Rescode.

#### 14.0 STANDARD B14- ACCESS.

Access has been designed to allow safe and efficient movements within the development and to provide safe movement exiting from the site.

The development provides for sufficient access by service, emergency & delivery vehicles.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B14 of Rescode.



#### 15.0 STANDARD B15- PARKING LOCATION.

The garages proposed within the development has been located next to the unit & have been designed to provide occupants access either through the front garage tilt/roller door or through the pedestrian door with access via individual private open space areas, and directly into the residence.

The proposed units has no windows located within 1.50m of the shared driveway or neighbouring garage.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B15 of Rescode

#### 16.0 STANDARD B16- PARKING PROVISION.

The proposed 2 No bedroom units have been provided with a carspace and the 3 No bedroom units have been provided with 2 No car spaces.

The single garage has been designed with a minimum width of 3.5 metres. The double garage has been designed with a minimum width of 5.5 metres.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B16 of Rescode.

#### 17.0 <u>STANDARD B17- SIDE AND REAR SETBACKS.</u>

Setbacks have been designed to be a minimum of 1.00 metres from the side (Townhouse No 1) & a 5.963 m setback to the rear boundary (Townhouse No 8).

The proposed open space setback is a min 3.00-metre minimum setback, and also an enlarged area is provided to accommodate an outdoor seating area.

All and any fascias, gutters, eaves etc. will not encroach on the minimum side & rear setback requirements stated in Standard B17 of Rescode that being no more than the 0.5m into the setbacks nominated by the Standard.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B17 of Rescode.

#### 18.0 STANDARD B18- WALLS ON BOUNDARIES.

There is walls to be built within 1000mm of any boundary and then 1.40m is the nearest other proposed setback from any boundary being that of the proposed unit no 7.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B18 of Rescode.

#### 19.0 STANDARD B19- DAYLIGHT TO EXISTING WINDOWS.

There are no existing habitable room windows which are affected by the proposed development, all a greater distance from the minimum setbacks required.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B19 of Rescode.



#### 20.0 STANDARD B20- NORTH FACING WINDOWS.

There are no north facing habitable room windows to the proposed development or to neighboring properties, which are effected by the development.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B20 of Rescued.

#### 21.0 STANDARD B21- OVERSHADOWING OPEN SPACE.

This development has been designed not to significantly overshadow any neighbouring existing secluded open space.

Neighboring properties shall receive over 5 hours of sunlight in secluded private open space areas between the hours of 9am to 3pm on September 22nd in an area greater than 40m<sup>2</sup>.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B21 of Rescued.

#### 22.0 STANDARD B22- OVERLOOKING.

The Development satisfies the requirement due to the proposed units being provided being treated with screening methods (obscure glazing) thus maximizing the privacy aspect to other neighboring dwellings and properties.

This development has been designed to kept views into existing secluded open space to a minimum.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B22 of Rescued.

#### 23.0 STANDARD B23- INTERNAL VIEWS.

There shall be no overlooking from habitable room windows of any dwelling within the development due to the design of the development and location of the proposed private open spaces.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B23 of Rescued.

#### 24.0 STANDARD B24- NOISE IMPACTS.

This development has been designed to contain noise sources that may affect existing neighbouring dwellings.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B24 of Rescued.

#### 25.0 STANDARD B25- ACCESSIBILITY.

The development has been designed to easily allow it to be made accessible and to accommodate the possible future needs of people with limited mobility. Proposed conc. pathways, landings & steps could be easily converted to ramps if the need did ever arise.

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It is considered that the development complies with Standard B25 of Rescued.

#### 26.0 STANDARD B26- DWELLING ENTRY.

The development has been designed to provide the units with a separate entrance to ensure individual identity, clear visibility to visitor's etc. and personal security.

It is considered that the proposed units have been positioned to allow individual identity from the street creating a sense of personal address.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B26 of Rescued.

#### 27.0 STANDARD B27- DAYLIGHT TO NEW WINDOWS.

Habitable room windows have been provided an outdoor space clear to the sky with a minimum dimension of 1 metre clear to the sky.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B27 of Rescode

#### 28.0 STANDARD B28- PRIVATE OPEN SPACE.

The proposed units has been provided with over the minimum 40 sq m. of private open space all with convenient access from a living room.

Each private opens space area will receive various levels of morning (east) & afternoon (north & west) sunlight throughout the year.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B28 of Rescode.

#### 29.0 STANDARD B29- SOLAR ACCESS.

It was neither appropriate nor practicable to locate open space areas in the direct northerly aspect however all open space areas have been located in a position where they will each receive sufficient sunlight from the northerly, southerly & westerly aspect.

Due to the location & angle of the open space to north there is no such "northern" or "southern" wall that will have an affect on the development.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B29 of Rescode.

#### 30.0 STANDARD B30- STORAGE.

As part of the development each unit has been provided with 6m3 of storage facilities in the form of storage sheds or storage area at rear of Garage.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B30 of Rescode.



#### 31.0 STANDARD B31- DESIGN DETAIL.

The units has been designed to respond to the surrounding area and the features of the site with established trees to remain where possible.

It is felt that 13 units (single & double storey) was appropriate to this site, providing a reduction in site cover while maintaining dwelling sizes appropriate to the proposed market niche.

The articulation of building mass enhances the sense of transition between neighbouring properties, and the combined effect of the existing dwelling at the front, is a built form that is suited to the area.

The building form is reflective of the surrounding area with pitched roof areas along with face brick / lining boards exists whilst windows throughout the area vary in style and materials, so a complimentary style has been chosen.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B31 of Rescode.

#### 32.0 STANDARD B32- FRONT FENCES.

There no front fence proposed for this development.

It is considered that the development complies with Standard B32 of Rescode.

#### 33.0 STANDARD B33- COMMON PROPERTY.

This development has been designed so there is common property within the development.

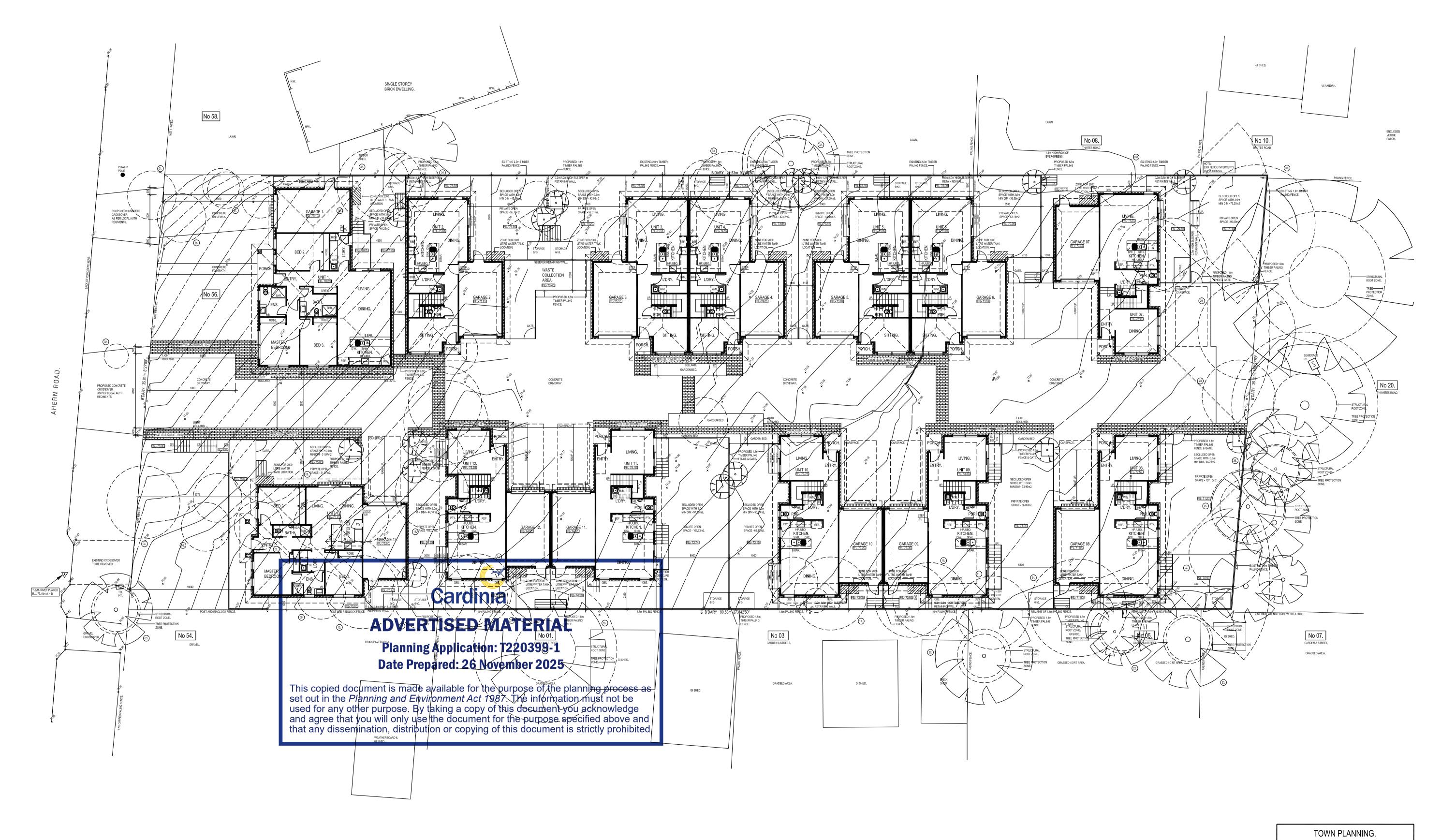

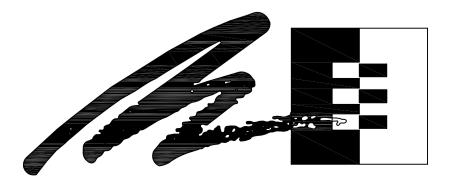
#### 34.0 STANDARD B34- SITE SERVICES.

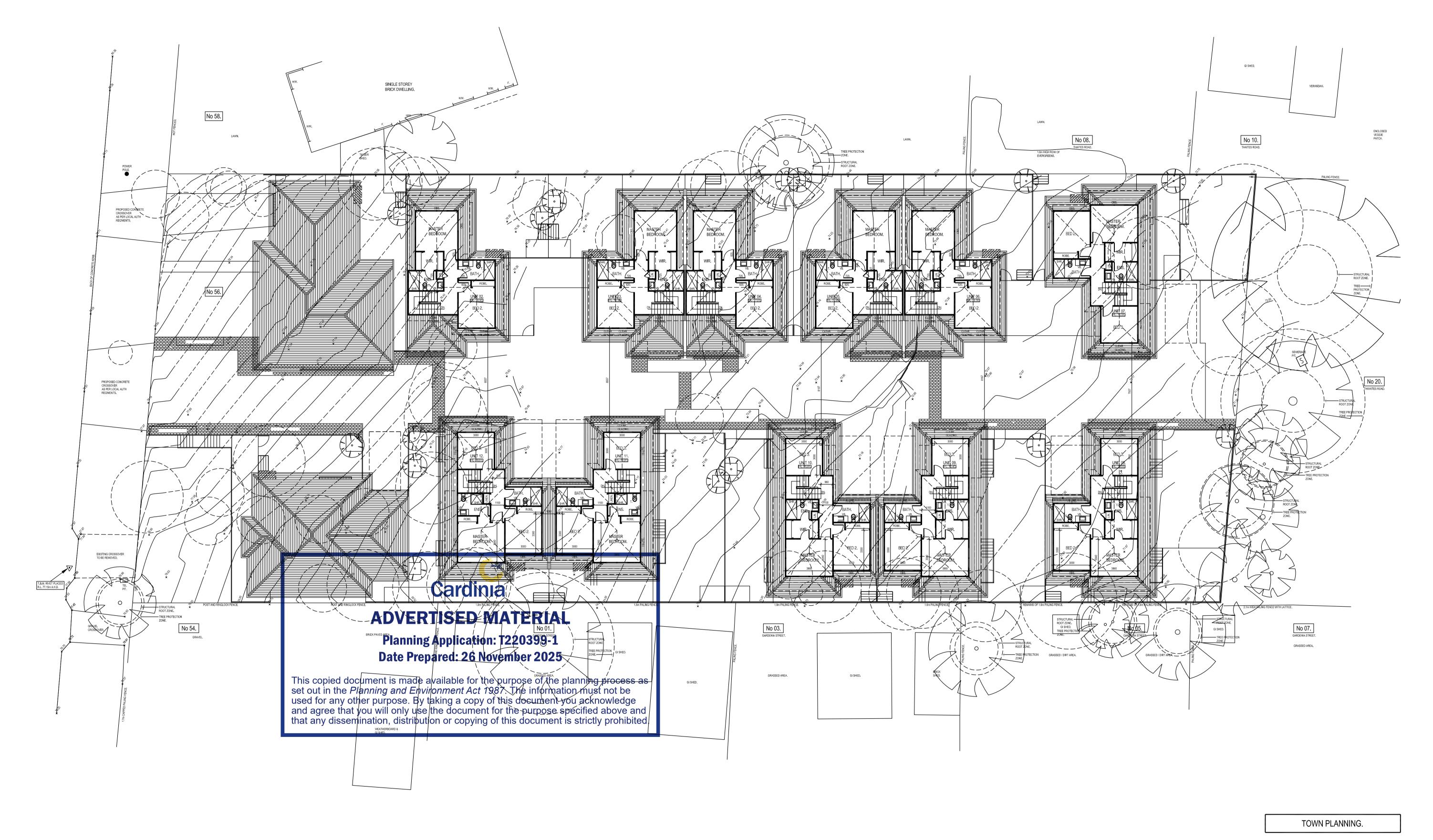
