Amendment to Planning Permit T040408

Amendment Proposal: Removal of all conditions referencing composting and extension of operating hours at Drovers Place, Pakenham

Site address: 14 Drovers Place, Pakenham

Permitted activity: Use & development of land for the purposes of waste recycling & composting facility generally in accordance with approved plans.

Cleanaway Waste Management ('Cleanaway') re-opened the Pakenham site at the aforementioned address as a waste transfer station in August 2016. Cleanaway requests an amendment to the planning permit conditions to remove all references to the site operating as a composting facility as the site ceased operating as a composting facility in 2010. The document named *Pakenham PP conditions* is included with the application outlining those conditions that are to be removed from the permit.

Cleanaway also wish to extend the hours of operation of the transfer station from 7.30am to 4.30pm seven (7) days per week to 5.00am to 6.00pm seven (7) days per week. The extension of hours is required to improve transport efficiencies at the site.


The plans endorsed by Council on 3rd December 2015 have been amended to remove all references to composting, including the screening plant, finished product stockpiles, and windrows. The plan has been revised to show inclusion of a new inbound/outbound weighbridge and litter nets. In addition Cleanaway has made provision for a proposed new entrance to the site via Ridge Place to service a proposed truck depot and bin storage area in the eastern section of the site. Cleanaway requests the updated plan be endorsed by Council.


Furthermore, the Planning Permit is valid until 18 November 2019. As Cleanaway proposes to operate the site as a waste transfer station, we seek an extension of time to the Planning Permit for a further 10 years, until 18 November 2029.


